Andrew Sherrill is director of Education, Workforce, and Income Security issues at the U.S. Government Accountability Office in Washington, D.C. His responsibilities include GAO's work on employment and training programs and worker protection issues. He was appointed to GAO's Senior Executive Service in 2009. In his 20 years at GAO, he has led teams in producing reports for the Congress on a broad range of topics, including workforce development, unemployment insurance, workers' compensation programs, women in the labor force, welfare reform, foreign labor programs, and mass care after Hurricane Katrina. Mr. Sherrill has received numerous awards for leadership at GAO.

Mr. Sherrill has played a key role in GAO's oversight of state and local spending of Recovery Act funds. He has led GAO's work in Florida, one of 16 states GAO has monitored, and also led GAO's review of Recovery Act funds for employment and training programs.

Mr. Sherrill received his Ph.D. and M.A. from the University of Texas at Austin and his B.A. from Trinity University in San Antonio, Texas. In addition, he completed coursework in the masters program at the LBJ School of Public Affairs at the University of Texas at Austin. He is a member of the National Academy of Social Insurance.
