

## **PATRICIA A. BORRELLI**

**Chair – RISS National Policy Group**

**Executive Director - Middle Atlantic-Great Lakes Organized Crime Law Enforcement Network**

Patricia Borrelli currently serves as the Chair of the RISS National Policy Group. In this role, Ms. Borrelli presides over RISS-related meetings that address strategic planning, resolution of operational issues, advancement of information and decision making affecting the six RISS Centers, the nationwide organization, service delivery, member agencies and related partner organizations. Ms. Borrelli acts on behalf of the RISS Directors in emergency situations and brings issues or actions to the meetings for ratification.

Patricia Borrelli is the Executive Director of the Middle Atlantic-Great Lakes Organized Crime Law Enforcement Network (MAGLOCLLEN), and is responsible for the overall administration and management. Prior to her appointment as Executive Director in 2005, she held the position of Deputy Executive Director. As the Deputy Executive Director, Ms. Borrelli was responsible for the daily management of the MAGLOCLLEN office and field operations and oversaw the operations of the Analytical, Equipment, Field Services, Intelligence Services, and Training Units. Prior to her promotion to the position of Deputy Executive Director, she held a variety of significant positions within the organization. Ms. Borrelli began her career at MAGLOCLLEN in 1984. Ms. Borrelli serves as the RISS policy representative on the Assured SBU (Sensitive but Unclassified) Interoperability Senior Executive Forum of the Program Manager's Office for the Information Sharing Environment (PM-ISE). Ms. Borrelli also serves on the National Alliance of Gang Investigators Associations (NAGIA) and East Coast Gang Investigators Association (ECGIA) executive boards.
