

H.R. 4745 – The FY 2015 Transportation, Housing and Urban Development Appropriations Bill

House Adopted Amendments

Walberg (R-MI) – The amendment strikes language in the bill related to joint federal and state activities on motorcycle fatality proposals. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Butterfield (D-NC) – The amendment increases funding for the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Technical Assistance and Training account by \$2 million, offset by a reduction in FTA Administrative Expenses. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Griffin (R-AR) – The amendment increases the Pipeline and Hazardous Material Safety Administration (PHMSA) Operation Expenses account by \$500,000, offset by a reduction in FTA Administrative Expenses. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Duffy (R-WI) – The amendment increases funding within Homeless Assistance Grants for the continuum of care and Rural Housing Stability Programs by \$10 million. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Conyers (D-MI) – The amendment increases funds for the national homeless data analysis project within Homeless Assistance Grants by \$2 million. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Lee (D-CA) – The amendment increases funding for the Fair Housing Initiatives Program by \$10 million, offset by a reduction in HUD's Information Technology Fund. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Grayson (D-FL) – The amendment increases translation services within the Fair Housing Initiatives program by \$150,000. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Waters (D-CA) – The amendment prohibits funding for HUD to relocate any asset management positions within the Office of Multifamily Housing. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Holmes Norton (D-DC) – The amendment prohibits funding in the bill to be used in contravention of the 5th or 14th Amendments to the Constitution or Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Daines (R-MT) – The amendment prohibits funding to issue regulations that increase insurance coverage minimums required of trucking and bus companies. **The amendment was adopted on a vote of 214-212.**

DeFazio (D-OR) – The amendment prohibits funding from being used to approve certain new foreign air carrier permits or exemption applications except those in compliance with existing law. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Jackson Lee (D-TX) – The amendment prohibits funding for FTA Transit Formula Grants to be used in contravention of Sec. 5309 of title 49, U.S. Code. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

DeSantis (R-FL) – The amendment prohibits funding for HUD to repay any loan made, guaranteed, or insured by HUD. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Grayson (D-FL) – The amendment prohibits funding to award a contract to a company that has been convicted of, or is currently indicted/civilly charged for a range of crimes, or has delinquent taxes of more than \$3,000 within a three year period of the offered contract. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Garamendi (D-CA) – The amendment prohibits funding for ships in the National Defense Ready Reserve from being crewed, owned, or maintained by foreign entities. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Gosar (R-AZ) – The amendment prohibits funding to implement, enforce, or administer the Affirmatively Furthering Fair Housing Rule proposed by HUD. **The amendment was adopted on a vote on 219-207.**

Gosar (R-AZ) – The amendment prohibits funding to administer the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration's National Roadside Survey. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Fleming (R-LA) – The amendment prohibits funding to acquire a camera that collects or stores vehicle license plate numbers. **The amendment was adopted on a vote on 255-171.**

Royce (R-CA) – The amendment prohibits funding for the Public Housing Trust Fund. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Denham (R-CA) – The amendment prohibits funding for high-speed rail in California or for the California High-Speed Rail Authority. **The amendment was adopted on a vote of 227-186.**

Grijalva (D-AZ) – The amendment prohibits funding for contracts that violate the Fair Labor Standards Act. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Schock (R-IL) – The amendment prohibits funding for Tenant-Based Rental Assistance housing vouchers, if the payment standard of the vouchers exceeds 120% of fair market rental value. **The amendment was adopted on a vote of 210-209.**

Higgins (D-NY) – The amendment prohibits funding to terminate a jurisdiction's status as a "metropolitan city" with respect to its ability to receive a Community Development Block Grant. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Grayson (D-FL) – The amendment prohibits funding to award extra payments to contractors whose contractors are behind schedule or over budget. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Yoho (R-FL) – The amendment prohibits funding to promulgate, implement, or enforce any regulations mandating GPS tracking or event data recorders in light-duty non-commercial passenger motor vehicles. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Gingrey (R-GA) – The amendment prohibits funding to provide mortgage insurance to any prospective borrower who provides only an Individual Taxpayer Identification Number as their only form of identification. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

DeLauro (D-CT) – The amendment prohibits funding to award contracts to corporations incorporated or chartered in Bermuda or the Cayman Islands. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Gingrey (R-GA) – The amendment prohibits funding to subsidize Amtrak’s food and beverage service. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Sessions (R-TX) – The amendment prohibits funding to support Amtrak’s route that sustains the highest financial loss. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Bass (D-CA) – The amendment allows for local hiring preferences for projects funded by the bill. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Engel (D-NY) – The amendment prohibits funding for agencies to lease or purchase new light-duty vehicles except in accordance with Federal Fleet Performance Standards. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**
