**AMENDMENT TO ENERGY AND WATER
APPROPRIATIONS BILL
OFFERED BY MR. FRELINGHUYSEN OF NEW
JERSEY**

Amend title V to read as follows (and amend the report accordingly):

1 **TITLE V—EMERGENCY SUPPLEMENTAL**
2 **FUNDING FOR DISASTER RELIEF**
3 (INCLUDING RESCISSION AND TRANSFERS OF FUNDS)
4 SEC. 501. (a) Effective on the date of enactment of
5 this Act, the unobligated balance of funds in excess of
6 \$1,028,684,400 made available for “Department of
7 Transportation—Federal Railroad Administration—Cap-
8 ital Assistance for High Speed Rail Corridors and Inter-
9 city Passenger Rail Service” by title XII of Public Law
10 111–5 is hereby rescinded, and the remaining amount is
11 hereby transferred to and merged with the following ac-
12 counts of the Corps of Engineers—Civil in the following
13 amounts for fiscal year 2011, to remain available until ex-
14 pended, for emergency expenses for repair of damage
15 caused by the storm and flood events occurring in 2011:
16 (1) “Construction”, \$376,000.

1 (2) "Mississippi River and Tributaries",
2 \$589,505,000.

3 (3) "Operation and Maintenance",
4 \$204,927,000.

5 (4) "Flood Control and Coastal Emer-
6 gencies", \$233,876,400.

7 (b) With respect to each amount transferred in sub-
8 section (a), the Chief of Engineers, acting through the As-
9 sistant Secretary of the Army for Civil Works, shall pro-
10 vide, at a minimum, a weekly report to the Committees
11 on Appropriations of the House of Representatives and the
12 Senate detailing the allocation and obligation of such
13 amount, beginning not later than one week after the date
14 of the enactment of this Act.

15 (c) Each amount transferred in subsection (a) is des-
16 ignated as an emergency pursuant to section 3(c)(1) of
17 H. Res. 5 (112th Congress).
