

THE 2021 TRUMP BUDGET

UNDERMINES INFRASTRUCTURE

President Trump's fiscal year 2021 budget proposes massive cuts and the outright elimination of discretionary programs that improve our transportation infrastructure and make housing more affordable and accessible.

Cuts Port Infrastructure Programs

Zeroes out the Port Infrastructure Development Program, which funds improvements at America's ports to improve efficiency, boost commerce and improve safety.

Slows Progress on Rail Safety Improvements

Eliminates the Federal-State Partnership for State of Good Repair, which funds grants to address the state of good repair backlog in our rail infrastructure.

Disinvests in Affordable Housing

Eliminates the HOME Investments Partnership Program, which funds affordable housing production.

Threatens Housing Discrimination Policies

Reduces the budget for the Office of Fair Housing and Equal Opportunity at HUD by \$5.3 million, threatening the enforcement of housing discrimination policies that aim to achieve diverse and inclusive communities.

Cuts Programs that Help Individuals Affected by Homelessness

Reduces funding for HUD's Homeless Assistance Grants by \$4 million, limiting resources available to States, local governments, and nonprofits that work to end homelessness.
