FUNDING FOR THE PEOPLE



COMBATS RUSSIAN AGGRESSION

- Bolsters Ukraine with \$300 million for the Ukraine Security Assistance Initiative
- Includes \$300 million for allies and partners in the region, including \$180 million for the Baltic Security Initiative, \$40 million for Georgia, \$30 million for Poland, \$30 million for Romania, and \$20 million for Bulgaria

PROMOTES GLOBAL DEMOCRACY

- Increases funding for modernization to counter China and other near-peer adversaries providing \$25.9 billion to procure 13 Navy ships and \$1.3 billion for the Navy's Conventional Prompt Strike program
- Protects a free and open Indo-Pacific with an additional \$75 million for Homeland Defense Radar-Hawaii and an additional \$80 million for the Guam Defense System
- Supports international security cooperation programs with countries in Indo-Pacific Command, including Maritime Security Programs
- Fully funds the State Partnership Program which builds relationships between the National Guard and 93 nations around the globe

SUPPORTS SERVICE MEMBERS AND MILITARY FAMILIES

- Support a 2.7 percent pay raise for all 2.1 million uniformed U.S. service members and approximately 750,000 civilian Defense Department employees
- Adds \$397 million above the President's request for basic allowances for housing and subsistence to address rising housing and food prices
- Provides \$167 million to ensure all DoD personnel earn at least a \$15 per hour
- Includes \$516 million for school construction and \$24.2 million for childcare fee assistance

CONFRONTS THE CLIMATE CRISIS AND IMPROVES THE ENVIRONMENT AND FACILITIES

- Historic investments in clean energy and climate adaptation to protect facilities, readiness, and global security
- Increases Environmental Restoration activities by more than \$400 million above the President's request, of which more than \$200 million is for PFOS/PFOA and AFFF cleanup
- Provides a \$1.6 billion increase for Facilities Sustainment, Restoration, and Modernization
- Directs \$686 million to respond to the Red Hill fuel spill

ADDRESSES GENDER-BASED VIOLENCE AND DOMESTIC EXTREMISM

- Tackles sexual assault with \$97 million to implement the recommendations of the Independent Review Commission on Sexual Assault in the Military
- Directs the Defense Department to report on extremist ideologies
