- Should not exceed five pages
- Should be an attachment to your email
- Typed on standard 8.5 by 11 inch letter size paper
- Double spaced in 12 point font with one inch margins
- Include the author’s name, title, and institutional affiliation (if any) at the top of the first page.
- Clearly identify the agency, program, and recommended funding amount
- Do not include color or detailed photos; however, the use of charts, tables, appropriate bold type, and bullets are acceptable.
