Each Member will be provided five minutes for remarks, and their complete testimony will be included in the public hearing record. The order of appearance and additional hearing details will be provided prior to the hearing.

For Members participating in-person and Members submitting testimony for the record, written testimony will be due to the subcommittee by Monday, May 6, 2024, at 5:00 p.m.

All written testimony should comply with the following guidelines:

- Testimony may not exceed five pages.
- Testimony must be double-spaced on letter size paper (8.5" x 11") with one-inch margins and at least 12-point font.
- Clearly indicate the Member's name and district at the top of the first page.
- Do not include color or detailed photos, as the hearing volume will be photographically reproduced. Use of charts, tables, and bullet points are acceptable, as long as they are within the five-page maximum.
