Garage Security Implementation Plan: The Committee
 commends the Sergeant at Arms of the House of Rep resentatives and the Capitol Police for their work to secure
 the Capitol Complex. The Committee notes that a plan
 to install magnetometers at the entrances to the House
 office buildings leading from the garages is a significant
 step forward in closing one of the last gaps in internal
 building security. Having said that, it is clear that the ga rage magnetometer program as presented will not be oper-

1 ational in all of the House office buildings, making it less 2 effective than a program in which all three buildings could be secured simultaneously. Nonetheless, comprehensive 3 garage security should move forward and the Committee 4 expects the Sergeant at Arms and the Capitol Police to 5 implement those security efforts after providing a plan 6 that will outline how the program will be implemented in 7 all garages. Furthermore the Committee encourages the 8 Sergeant at Arms and the Capitol Police to hold additional 9 briefings to re-introduce and re-orient offices to the details 10 of the plan required above, including providing informa-11 12 tion to new Members who will join the 115th Congress. Donating Computer Equipment: The Committee is aware 13 of several Member's desire to review the regulations that 14 outline the eligibility of, and process by which, House 15 equipment can be donated to local and State governments 16 as well as 501(c)(3) charities. The Committee believes this 17 is a worthwhile review and that the Committee on House 18 Administration is the proper committee of jurisdiction to 19 20 address any specific regulation changes.
