H.R. 5855 – The Fiscal Year 2013 Homeland Security Appropriations Bill

Floor Adopted Amendments

<u>Flake (R-AZ)</u> – The amendment adds \$43,000 to U.S. Customs and Border Protection to complete a workforce staffing model, offset by a \$50,000 cut to the office of the Secretary. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

<u>Grimm (R-NY)</u> – The amendment increases FEMA Urban Search and Rescue by \$7.6 million, offset by a cut to the Office of the Undersecretary for Management. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

<u>Clarke (D-MI) #1</u> – The amendment increases FEMA State and Local Grant Programs by \$10 million, offset by a cut to the DHS Office of the Undersecretary for Management. **The amendment passed on a vote of 211-202.**

<u>Poe (R-TX)</u> – The amendment increases the Border Fencing, Infrastructure, and Technology account by \$10 million, offset by a cut to the DHS Office of the Undersecretary for Management. The intent of the amendment is to increase funds for CBP communications infrastructure for border communities. **The amendment passed on a vote of 302-113.**

<u>Runyan (R-NJ)</u> – The amendment increases Firefighter Assistance Grants by \$5 million, offset by a cut to the Office of the Undersecretary for Management. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

<u>Bishop (R-UT)</u> – The amendment increases funding to the Air and Marine Interdiction account by \$624,000, offset by a \$3 million cut to the Border Security Fencing, Infrastructure, and Technology account. **The amendment passed on a vote of 230-186.**

<u>Wasserman Schultz (D-FL)</u> – The amendment designates \$20 million for child exploitation within Immigration and Customs Enforcement. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

<u>Cravaack (R-MN)</u> – The amendment directs \$10 million within TSA Aviation Security for the Federal Flight Deck Officer Program. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

<u>Dold (R-IL)</u> – The amendment increases Coast Guard Search and Rescue Operations in the Great Lakes by \$5.2 million, offset by a cut to Coast Guard automated systems. **The amendment passed on a voice vote.**

<u>Gardner (R-CO)</u> – The amendment requires the Coast Guard to comply with energy management requirements. **The amendment passed on a voice vote.**

Ellison (D-MN) – The amendment prohibits the use of funds in contravention of the Fifth and Fourteenth Amendments, Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1954, Sec. 809 (c)(1) of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1986, and Sec. 210401 (a) of the Violent Crime and Law Enforcement Act of 1994. The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.

- <u>Graves (R-MO)</u> The amendment prohibits funding for an Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) rule that would allow certain unlawful aliens to remain in the U.S. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**
- <u>Black (R-TN)</u> The amendment prohibits funding for the position of "Public Advocate" within ICE. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**
- <u>Flores (R-TX)</u> The amendment prohibits funds to implement a regulation under the Energy Independence and Security Act (section 526). The regulation prohibits federal contracts for alternative fuels, unless the alternative fuels are proven to produce less greenhouse gas than conventional fuels. This overly burdensome regulation would limit the ability of the federal government from exploring and using alternative fuel options. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**
- <u>King (R-IA)</u> The amendment prohibits funding to enforce an executive order that requires DHS funding recipients including local government offices to provide English translation services. **The amendment was adopted on a vote of 224-189.**
- <u>King (R-IA)</u> The amendment prohibits funding to enforce "Morton Memos." These memos direct priority enforcement of immigration law against a subset of illegal aliens, largely only those who have a criminal history. **The amendment was adopted on a vote of 238-175.**
- <u>Pierluisi (D-PR)</u> The amendment prohibits funds for Customs and Border Security Salaries and Expenses for collection of duties and taxes authorized to be levied, collected, and paid in Puerto Rico. The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.
- <u>Sullivan (R-OK)</u> The amendment prohibits funding from being used to terminate the Immigration and Customs Enforcement "287 (g)" program, which allows state and local law enforcement to receive training and delegated authority for immigration enforcement within their jurisdictions. **The amendment was adopted on a vote of 250-164.**
- <u>Barletta (R-PA)</u> The amendment prohibits funds from going to cities and towns that do not enforce federal immigration law. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**
- <u>Engel (D-NY)</u> The amendment prohibits funds to lease or purchase light duty vehicles not in compliance with the Presidential memorandum on alternative fuel vehicles. **The amendment was passed in an en bloc amendment on a voice vote.**
- <u>Price (R-GA)</u> The amendment prohibits funds from being used in circumvention and/or failure to enforce our nation's current immigration laws. **The amendment was passed in an en bloc amendment on a voice vote.**
- <u>Holt (D-NJ)</u> The amendment prohibits funds for armored unmanned aerial vehicles. **The** amendment was passed in an en bloc amendment on a voice vote.

<u>Cravaack (R-MN)</u> – The amendment prohibits funding for ICE to release criminal aliens, in violation of existing law. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**
