REVISED SUBALLOCATION OF BUDGET ALLOCATIONS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2015

The Committee on Appropriations submits the following report on the revised suballocation of budget allocations for fiscal year 2015.

As required by section 302(b) of the Congressional Budget Act of 1974, this report subdivides the allocation of fiscal year 2015 spending authority provided to the Committee on Appropriations by the House pursuant to section 115 of the Bipartisan Budget Act of 2013 (P.L. 113-67) as well as section 3 of H. Res. 557.

This report supersedes the interim suballocations reported by the Committee in House Report 113-425, as made applicable by the House of Representatives (113th Congress). The Committee adopted the interim suballocations because of the special circumstances it faced as it began the fiscal year 2015 appropriations process. In contrast, this report fully allocates the overall allocation given to the Committee and provides 302(b) suballocations to all 12 subcommittees, allowing it to proceed with the development of its appropriations bills under regular order.
