The report is consistent with the "Allocation of Spending Authority to House Committee on Appropriations" included in the Joint Explanatory Statement of the Committee of Conference for S. Con. Res. 11, the concurrent resolution on the budget for fiscal year 2016 as well as with the current law levels for discretionary spending required by the Budget Control Act of 2011 (P.L. 112–25) and enforced through sequestration.

The Committee, in distributing the allocation among the 12 regular appropriations bills, has remained within the allocation's totals.
